- Nearly 70% of all Veteran suicides are by firearm.
- Providers can enhance suicide prevention efforts with all the Veterans they serve.
- Increasing time and space between someone in a suicidal crisis and a lethal mean

saves lives. Finding out the best ways to create this space is vital.



Course Objectives:

- To articulate the importance of addressing lethal means as a part of suicide prevention.
- To facilitate an open discussion about lethal means safety measures with Veterans
- To demonstrate knowledge, skills and comfort discussing means safety with Veterans who are at elevated risk for suicide.
